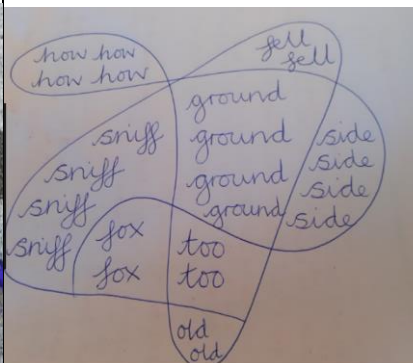


GPS Week 3 Session 1	Words spelt with the w-or phoneme

Parent	Some phonemes have alternative spellings and it is very important that the children learn all the graphemes for all of them. Over the next few weeks, we will be learning how a vowel can sound differently after the letter 'w'. This week we are learning about the phoneme w - or which is important for their work on worms as well as spelling other words . It's all very worthwhile .
