Our writing across these 2 terms will focus on a number of different writing genres including:

Mystery Writing – Writing to Persuade – Information Texts – Characterisation and Dialogue – Rewriting a story from a different Perspective

Our texts will include: Stormbreaker (by Anthony Horowitz) and Pig Heart Boy (by Malorie Blackman)

Maths

We will continue to use the White Rose scheme to follow the topic areas of: Ratio; Algebra; Decimals; Fractions, Decimals and Percentages; Area, Perimeter and Volume; Statistics.

We will continue building core numeracy skills of arithmetic and reasoning within these units and by revising previous units as maths starters each day.

History

Term 3: Manchester Man – we will learn about change starting in the Georgian era and including the rise of steam with the industrial revolution

Term 4: In this term we will learn about the Victorians and why our school has the name of Sir Henry Fermor

Geography

Term 3: Changing Birmingham – We will consider the way in which our cities continue to change and develop over time

Term 4: Jamaica – We broaden our geographical knowledge by switching our focus to topics of migration, diversity and tourism

Science

Term 3: Classification – We will learn how living things are classified into broad groups according to common, observable characteristics, including similarities and differences. We will also give reasons for classifications.

Term 4: Circulatory System – We will be able to identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. We will also learn about impacts of diet and exercise on health.

Music

We will be creating music with multiple sections. To do this we will learn about a range of musical structures. We will create music of our choosing: instrumental, rap or songs using different sections and demonstrating that we can play together and make decisions about performance

Computing

We will continue to focus on gaining experience and confidence in day-to-day use of computer software including word processing, spreadsheets and presentations
