

Art Week 5	The Snail - Henri Matisse
Starter	This week we are going to make another artwork about a mini beast. Please watch the video to find out more.
Parent	This week they are looking at a collage artwork which is made from cut out coloured paper. If you have any coloured card or paper this would be ideal however if you don't then it would work with coloured parts of magazine pages, old wallpaper, fabric or if you have none of these then they could just draw shapes and colour them in with pencils, crayons or felt-tips. It would also work well using a 'paint' program on a laptop or tablet if they would prefer this.
Activity with your child	After watching the video, please have a go at creating an artwork inspired by the Matisse piece. If they do not have any ideas for their own mini beast (last year there were lots of ladybirds and butterflies but some interesting beetles, caterpillars and bees too) then they can just create a snail similar to the one that Matisse made. Mrs Oram created these two with tissue
