

North America Week 6	Geography
Starter	Begin by watching https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/what-is-north-america-like/activities/2
Parent	If they have been listening to the chapters in James and the Giant Peach, they will have heard that James has arrived in New York. So this week in Geography (although we are still learning about Africa in English) they are going to fly to the continent of North America. Please watch the video lesson from Oak National Academy, although it is aimed at Year 1 children it is a very good reinforcement of all the geographical knowledge that they have learnt this term and gives them an introduction to North America. It concludes with a useful story about Africa called 'The Ugly Five' by Julia Donaldson that introduces other animals that they might like to choose to write about for their English task.
Activities with your child	Complete the activities covered in the lesson by drawing animals that can be found in the Everglades. If they would like to do any further learning about North America there are some resources on the website for them to explore such as the BBC power point, list of the states in the USA or a North American fact file to complete.
