Although the lesson is aimed at Year 1, the children have not yet learnt about Africa at SHF, so it is a good introduction. There is a useful reinforcement activity reminding them about identifying and ordering the continents in size at the beginning. It then proceeds to give some key vocabulary and facts about this continent which is really important to learn to support the lessons in English and Art this week. |
