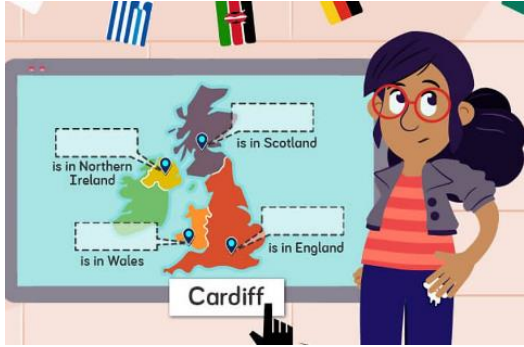


Geography Week 3	Maps and mapping
Starter	Watch the introductory film clip https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zyhp34j/articles/z4v3jhw to find out about the United Kingdom's physical and human features.
Parent	This week we are learning about the United Kingdom. The children have to be able to name the 4 countries of the UK and the capital cities. Look at the pictures on the bitesize website showing the 4 capital cities. Ask questions such as: Have they ever been to any of them? What do they remember? What do they know about the capital cities? Why is the country called the United Kingdom? What do you know about the flags? What else would they like to find out about the United Kingdom?
Internet activity with your child	Complete the activities https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zyhp34j/articles/z4v3jhw to label the countries of the United Kingdom  and then the second activity to label the capital cities. 
Parent	If they would like to record any of their learning there are printed sheets for labelling on the website, flag colouring or they could challenge themselves to create a written fact file about a city in the UK in their Extraordinary home learning books.
