



10 multiplied by 4 is equal to 40

$$10 \times 4 = 40$$

5 multiplied by 3 is equal to 15

$$5 \times 3 = 15$$

2 multiplied by 6 is equal to 12

$$2 \times 6 = 12$$



$$5 \times 4 \text{ (true)}$$

$$5 + 5 + 5 + 5 \text{ (true)}$$

four 5s (true)

four groups with five in each group (true)

$$4 + 4 + 4 \text{ (false)}$$

5 multiplied by 4 (true)

$$3 \times 5 \text{ (false)}$$



Children should draw an appropriate picture to match each problem.

$$2 \times 4 = 8$$

$$10 \times 3 = 30$$

$$5 \times 5 = 25 \text{ (or } 5 \times 5p = 25p)$$

Children draw a picture and write a story to represent each calculation.

$$10 \times 2 = 20$$

$$2 \times 8 = 16$$

$$5 \times 6 = 30$$
