Most fleas drink the blood of animals. Some drink human blood too. Spot ten.



Female garden spiders are bigger than males and often eat them after mating. Spot eight spiders.

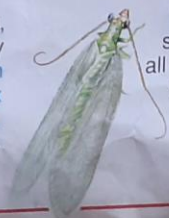


Houseflies' mouths are like a mop, soaking up liquid food. Find ten houseflies.



Cinnabar moth

Unlike most moths, cinnabar moths fly by day. Spot seven moths and six caterpillars.



Lacewings sleep somewhere warm all winter. They turn brown while they sleep. Find 14.



Cockroaches have flat bodies. They can squeeze under things to hide. Spot 11.

Female common blue butterfly

Only male common blue butterflies are really blue. Spot four of each sex.



Honeybees carry yellow pollen from flowers in "baskets" on their back legs. Can you find ten?



Zebra spiders creep up behind their victims and pounce on them. Find five.



Their name means "100 feet" but no centipedes have that many. Can you spot six?



Wasps like anything sweet, including our food. They'll sting you if you annoy them. Spot 13.



Devil's coach-horses arch their bodies to scare off enemies. Spot six coach-horses.

Earwigs lift their fierce-looking tails if they are scared, but they can't hurt you. Spot nine.

Greenflies suck the juice out of plants for their food. Can you spot 17?



Spittlebugs blow air and spit out of their bottoms to make foam. Find eight bugs hidden in foam.
