Parents and siblings stick around for the fun!

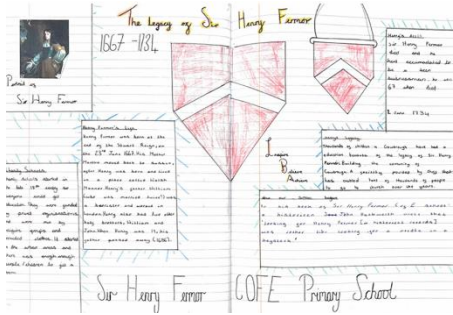
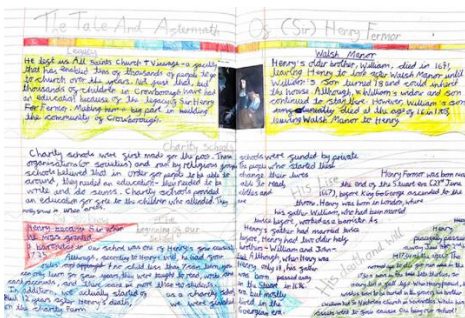
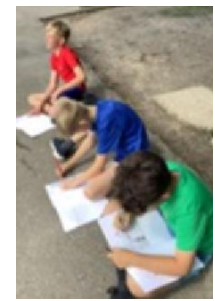
